LAKE GARDA: HILLS





Peschiera del Garda - Valeggio sul Mincio - Borghetto

This motor-touristic itinerary is perfect for those who want to really enjoy the charm of the Garda hinterland: 53 km that can be done easily even during the day, between ancient villages and unique views, from Lake Garda, between the Gardesane hills and the river Mincio.

DEPARTURE: Peschiera del Garda, a beautiful town surrounded by UNESCO heritage walls, rich in history that has its roots since prehistoric times.



Among the historical monuments, the Church of San Martino Vescovo in the city center, and going on, you can reach the inland towards Pozzolengo, with another UNESCO site and naturalistic oasis, the Frassino little lake, with its wonderful Sanctuary.

ARRIVAL: Valeggio sul Mincio, a town always located in the natural amphitheater of the morainic hills, particularly fascinating for the beauty of its landscapes and for the typical flavors of the gastronomic tradition, such as the "love knot" or tortellino. Going on, you can reach Borghetto of Valeggio sul Mincio, a magical and timeless place, characterized by a few houses and ancient mills immersed in a bucolic setting. It is one of the most beautiful villages in Italy.










LAKE GARDA: BREATHTAKING VIEWS





This motorcycle route, developed for about 25 km, once reached Costermano from the panoramic Garda lake road or from the Affi high road (faster). It offers many panoramic stops, where you can admire villages, landscapes and unique views of the lake, without forgetting typical and traditional dishes.

DEPARTURE: Costermano, a balcony on Lake Garda that offers breathtaking views. It contains unique naturalistic oases, like the Val dei Mulini. From here we reach Castion with its beautiful Villa Pellegrini Cipolla, a typical construction of late Veronese enlightenment. Going on the fraction of Marciaga, you reach Albisano, in the city of Torri del Benaco. Here you have the opportunity to take splendid walks among olive groves and woods, finally visiting the Scaligero castle and its

museum of local traditions. Then you can continue for the San Zeno di Montagna - VIllanova panoramic road.



ARRIVAL: Castelletto di Brenzone, a village located in a beautiful setting between mountain and lake, with architectural beauties and unique naturalistic areas, which especially enhance the connection between art and faith: the Church of San Zeno and the Church of Sant'Antonio (masterpieces of art romantic), the Church of San Nicola (with beautiful frescoes). Nature is enhanced by splendid views of the lake and from the paths that enter into Monte Baldo, wonderful especially in autumn.





VERONA AND VALPOLICELLA





This itinerary proposal is about Valpolicella, land characterized by round hills and large expanses of vineyards.

DEPARTURE: Pescantina, easily reachable from the junction of Verona Nord motorway and then head towards Sant'Ambroigio in

Valpolicella. Must visit, the beautiful parish church dedicated to San Giorgio.

Then, we continue for a few kilometers, reaching San Giorgio in Valpolicella, a small village of winemakers who, with passion, produce a truly superb local wine, that you absolutely have to taste.

Then, continuing through the little town of Mazzurega, Fiumane and Marano di Valpolicella, you get to the heart of this suggestive corner of Veneto. The route continues through the hills reaching Fane and then Negrar.

ARRIVAL: San Pietro in Cariano, where you can taste typical local dishes, combined of course with these particular wines of Valpolicella.
